



**HOW TO FIND
LONG LAKE CAMP
1945 WATERLOO ROAD**

From Bridgewater: (Highway 103, Exit 13)
Follow Route 325 through Wileville 10km to Newcomville. Turn left onto Route 210 towards Greenfield. Go 5km and turn to Waterloo. Go 10km to Long Lake Camp (on left). There are Long Lake Camp signs to Guide the way.

From Liverpool: (Highway 103, Exit 19)
Follow Route 8 for 20km to Middlefield. Turn right onto Route 210. Go 15km through Greenfield to Buckfield. Turn right toward Waterloo. Go 4km to Long Lake Camp (on right)
